Kapunda High School once again took a team of students and stock along to the Royal Adelaide Show, as part of their school Agricultural Studies program.

Eager students gave up their lunchtimes in terms 2 & 3 to prepare steers, sheep and goats, to be exhibited at the Royal Show.

The school's steers were *Haze*, a Murray Grey from Silver Pty Ltd and *Bentley*, a Poll Hereford from Morganvale Pastoral Pty Ltd. Teacher, Karen Bromley, says that the students did a fantastic job breaking in the steers, preparing them to showing standards. *Bentley* came fourth in his weight class.

Students also prepared two Boer goats, *Axel* and *Nitro*, from Kapunda Chevon. *Axel* came fourth in the Capretto class and *Nitro* came third in the Chevon class.

This year saw a large number of students working with the two pens of merino wethers, from Hilton Heath. At the end of the competition, KHS placed seventh in 'most valued skins', and fifth in 'best pen of three'.

Karen Bromley, Kapunda High School Agricultural Studies teacher, would like to thank everyone who helped and/or supported the Ag Club and show camp. A special thanks goes to the students, breeders of the animals, Steve O'Donnell and the Jones Family.
